Respected Madam:

We write this letter to you not only as a parent of our child *Eshaan Sivakumar* studying in class IIA of "our" school, but also as an individual with great concern and interest in the way future generations are nurtured in our society. Eshaan will be completing his pre-primary years in the school at the end of this academic session. Therefore, we would like to share with you, as the academic coordinator looking after our ward, a few experiences we have had over the course of past few years' association with the school.

#### First contact

The systems unique to our school such as the well balanced common food menu and home visits by the teachers pointed to the truly world class nurturing skills brought in by the administrators of the school. We could not believe that such innovative systems are being implemented in a school surrounded by so many mediocre educational institutions. These two years of our ward's association with the school truly cemented our faith in its management. It led to our belief that this school is truly "ours" and the school shares our commitment to not only educate that child, but in bringing up our child to develop into a fine individual.
