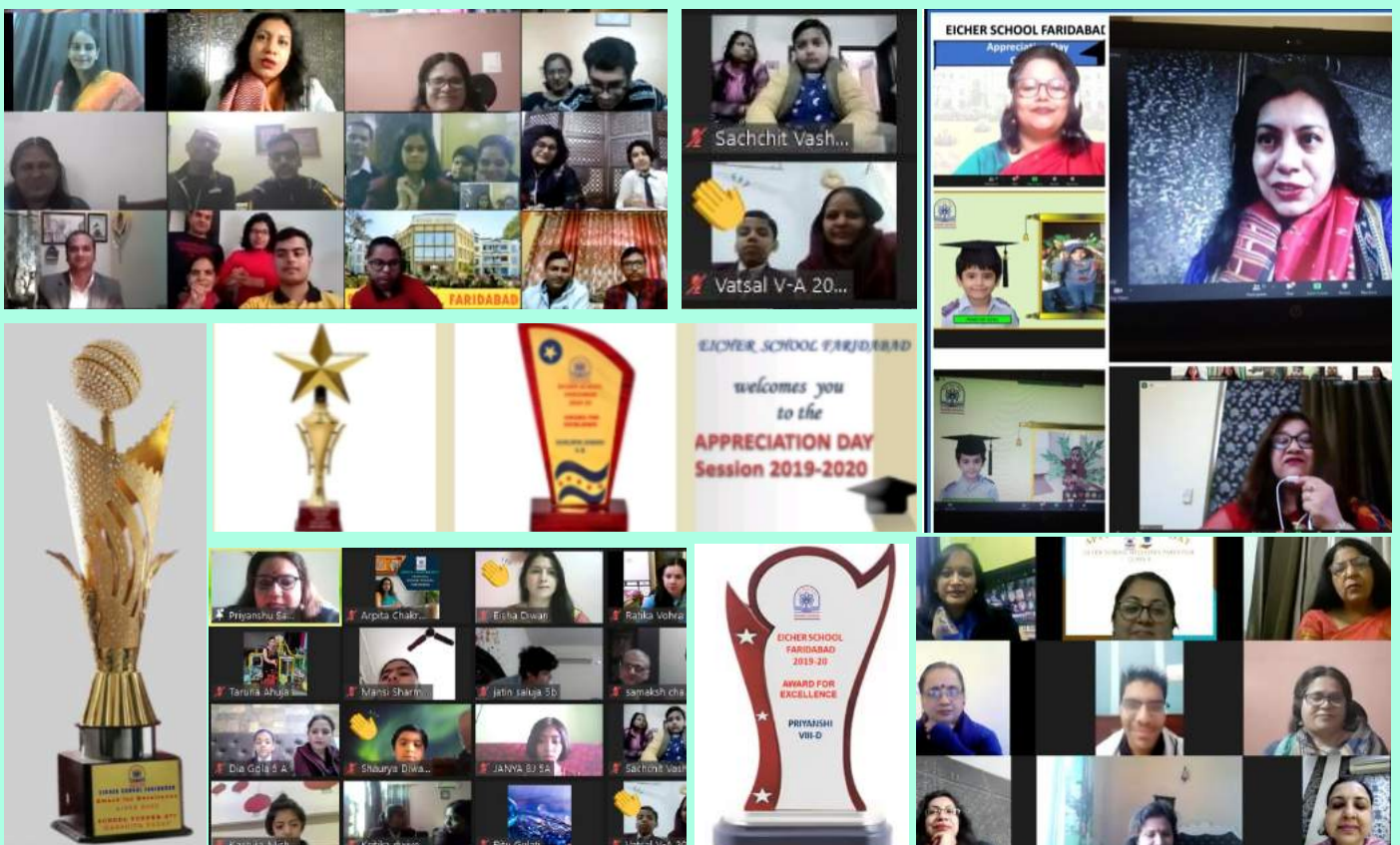
MOMENTOUS OCCASIONS

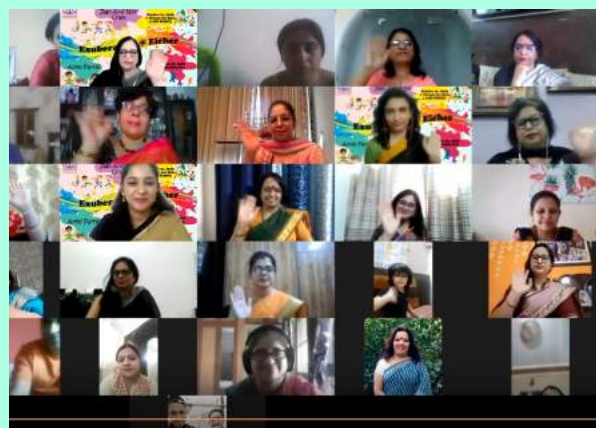

"Teaching is more than imparting knowledge; it is inspiring change."

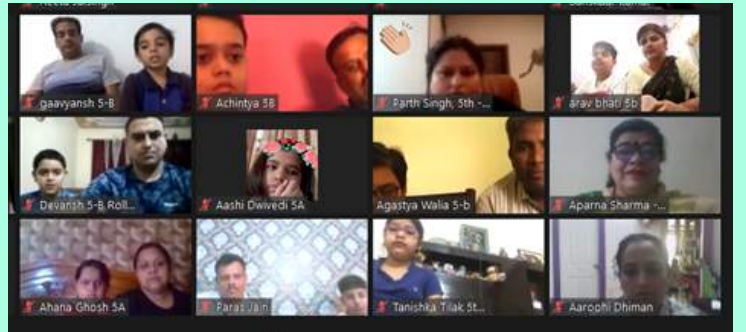

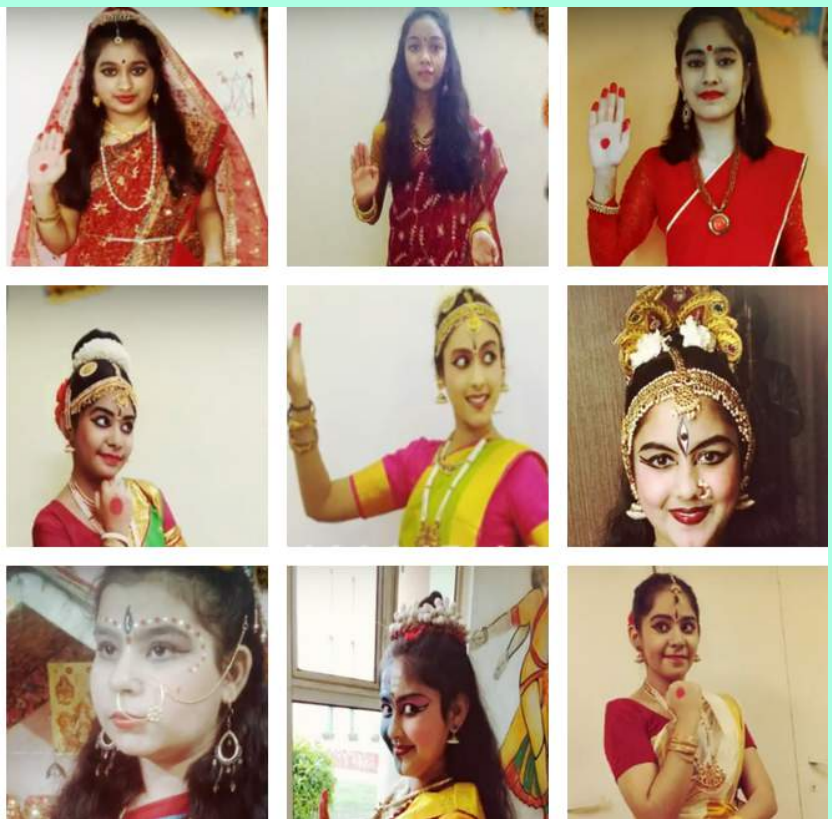
EID-E-MILAD-UN-NABI

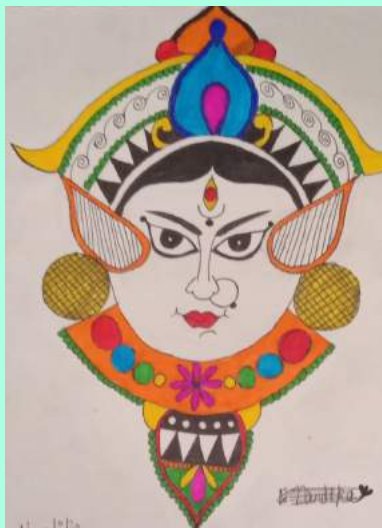


DURGA PUJA

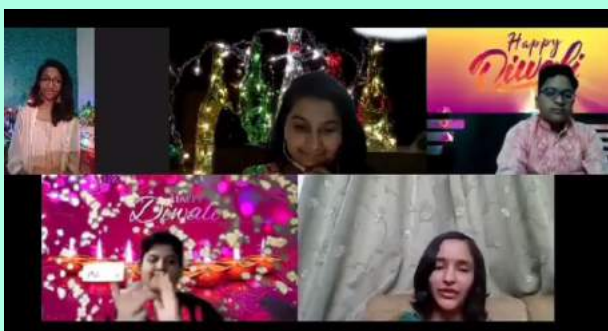
