




Experiential learning

An open house meet, 'Samvaad', was organized on April 23, 2022 for class VI. Parents were apprised with the options available for the third language as Sanskrit or French.



Presentations were given by the respective teacher in-charges to provide an overview of each subject. The students got better clarity regarding the choice they could make.
