## CLASS X



A total of 116 students appeared for CBSE Secondary School Examination 2022-23. They all performed exceptionally well and made everyone proud of their achievements. 17 students secured an aggregate of 90% and above while 34 scored between 80 to 90%.

Eshaan Sivakumar topped the list with 96.6% followed closely by Anushka Khandelwal with 96% each. The third place was shared by Arushi R Kamath and Shreya Kodnani who scored 95.8% each.

# FROM THE CAREER COUNSELLING CELL



Career Counselling is an immensely effective way of providing guidance to aspirants during their final years at school. # FROM THE CAREER COUNSELLING CELL

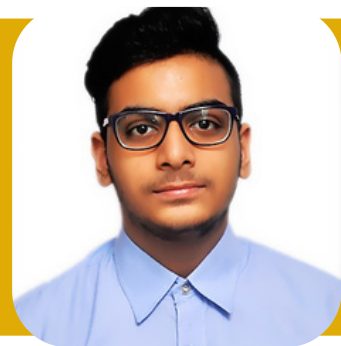

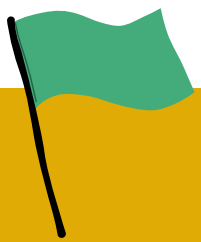
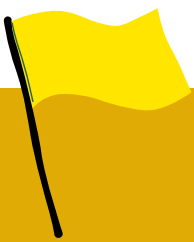




# INVESTITURE CEREMONY 2023-24

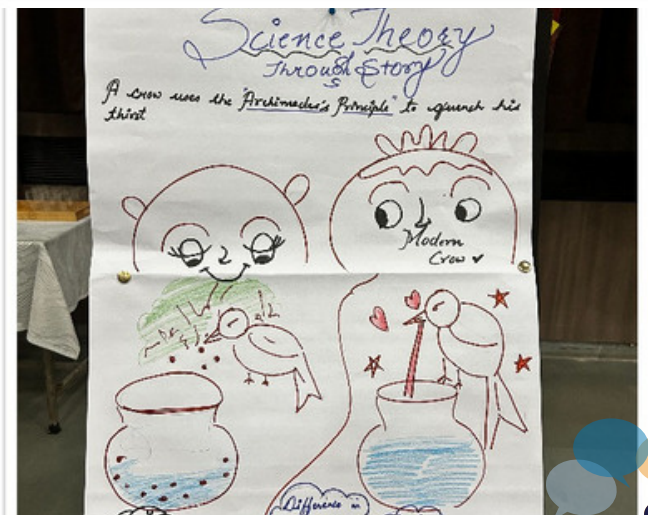

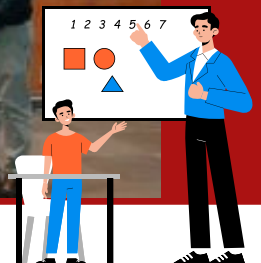

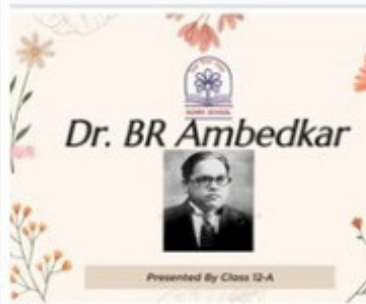




# CLASS ASSEMBLIES

# EICHER ACHIEVERS



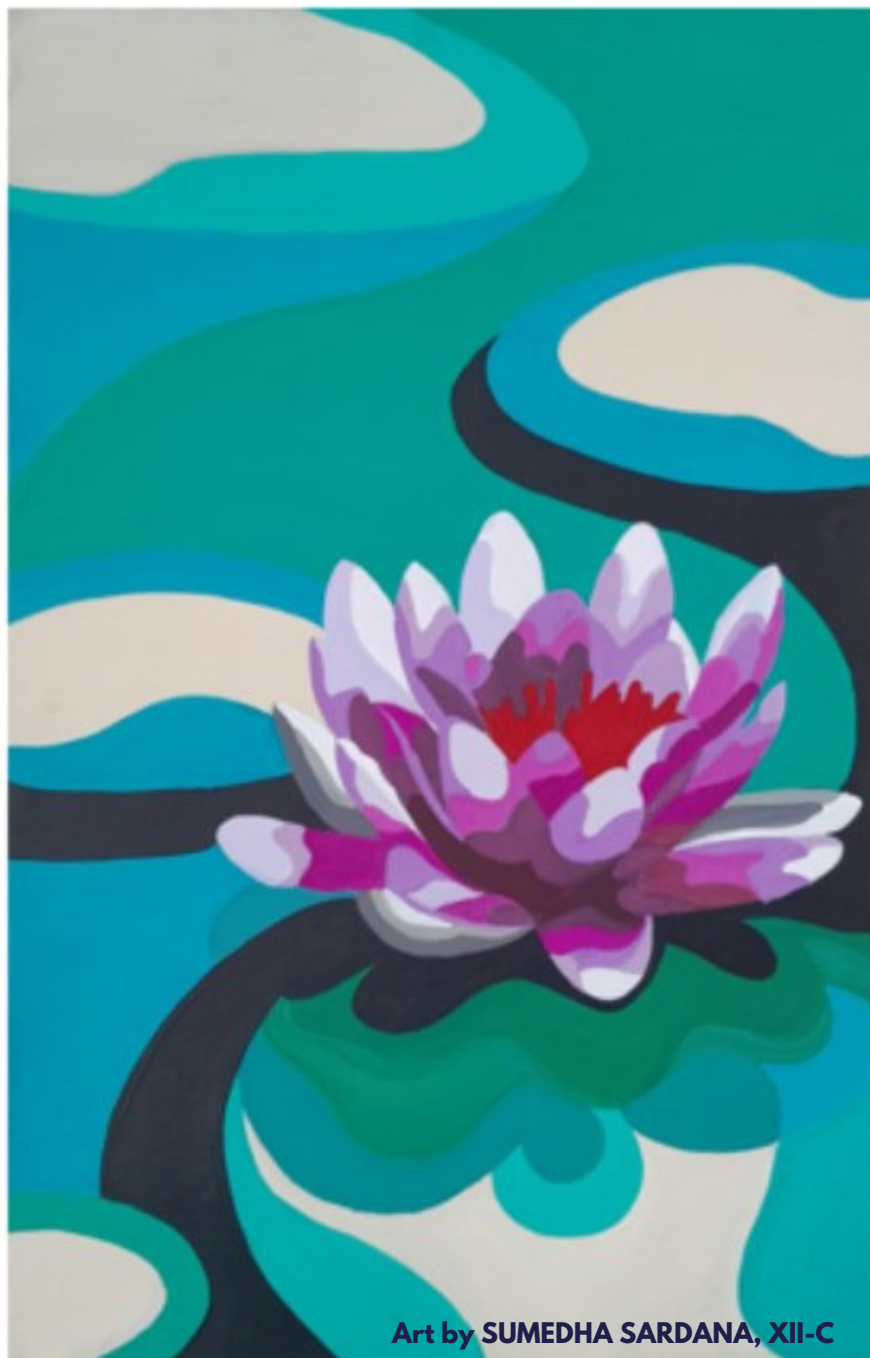
