Friendship Day

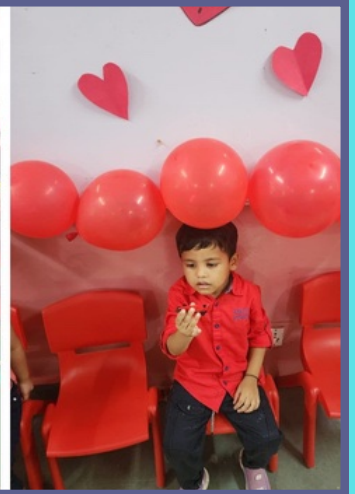


FY students celebrated the day on July 30, 2023 with their friends and class teachers and understood that 'A friend in need is a friend indeed.' They exchanged friendship bands.

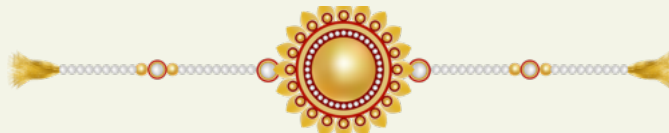


Enjoying a Rainy Day

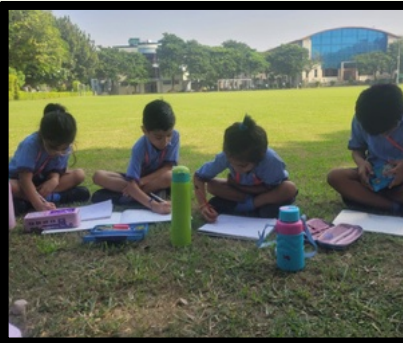
Health Checkup

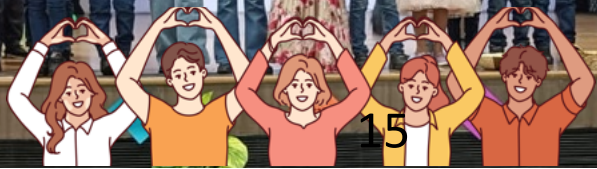
Janmashtami Celebration

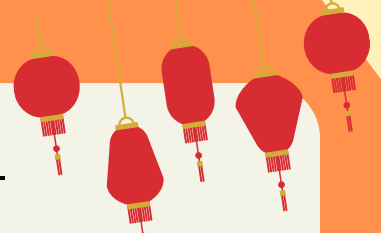

Adventure Camp in Mussoorie



Eicher School Faridabad organised an educational adventure camp to Mussoorie from September 26-30, 2023 for the students of classes IX-XII. 120 students along with 12 teachers took part in this extremely fun-filled camp which was helmed by Rocksport, Asia's largest adventure programme that provides meaningful learning environments and channelizes the energy of children in a progressive direction.

We began our overnight journey with great enthusiasm and anticipation on September 26 and reached our destination early the next morning. The scenic tranquillity of the hills took our breath away. We were excited to take pictures with our friends but our happiness was short-lived as our mobile phones were taken away from us. Little did we know that the days ahead would be so busy with activities that we would not even miss them.



Tents were allotted and after a heart-warming breakfast, we were divided into 3 groups of 40 each - The Blue Battalion, The Red Rangers and The Orange Warriors - which had a mix of students from all the classes.



Meticulously planned activities for the groups in rotation over three days ensured no confusion or hassle. Each activity followed a briefing by trained instructors. For our first adventure of the day, our group, The Blue Battalion, went for a short hike followed by zip lining. After returning to the campsite, we were asked to gather at the pool for an interesting river rafting relay where we were supposed to build our own rafts using tyres, bamboo and ropes. After this adrenaline pumping time, we gathered for evening snacks which were followed by camp games.

We kick started the next day at 6 am with yoga and later, set out for a trek of 4 kilometres which culminated with rock climbing and rappelling. Camp games like Mission Impossible and tent pitching helped in skill building.

To end our day on a serene note, we went for a calming night trek where we sat amongst the towering trees, listened to the insects and birds and experienced the serene untroubled nightlife of the mountains.



A spine chilling horror story session around the bonfire ended the day on a supercharged note. On the third and last day, we went for river trekking which was the highlight of the trip. Leeches and slippery rocks made it a daunting task but we took it as a challenge to expand our boundaries.

After returning, an exciting inter-group battle, Guerrilla Warfare took place. It involved 3 levels: the treasure hunt, catapult and tea making. In the evening, we had a knot making session after which we were finally given our phones back.

Then we assembled for the prize distribution ceremony. After honouring the students, teachers and the camp instructors with various awards like the Best Camper, Best Tent, Best Group etc., we danced to foot tapping music to end the trip on a scintillating note before we departed for school.

Trip to Nainital
