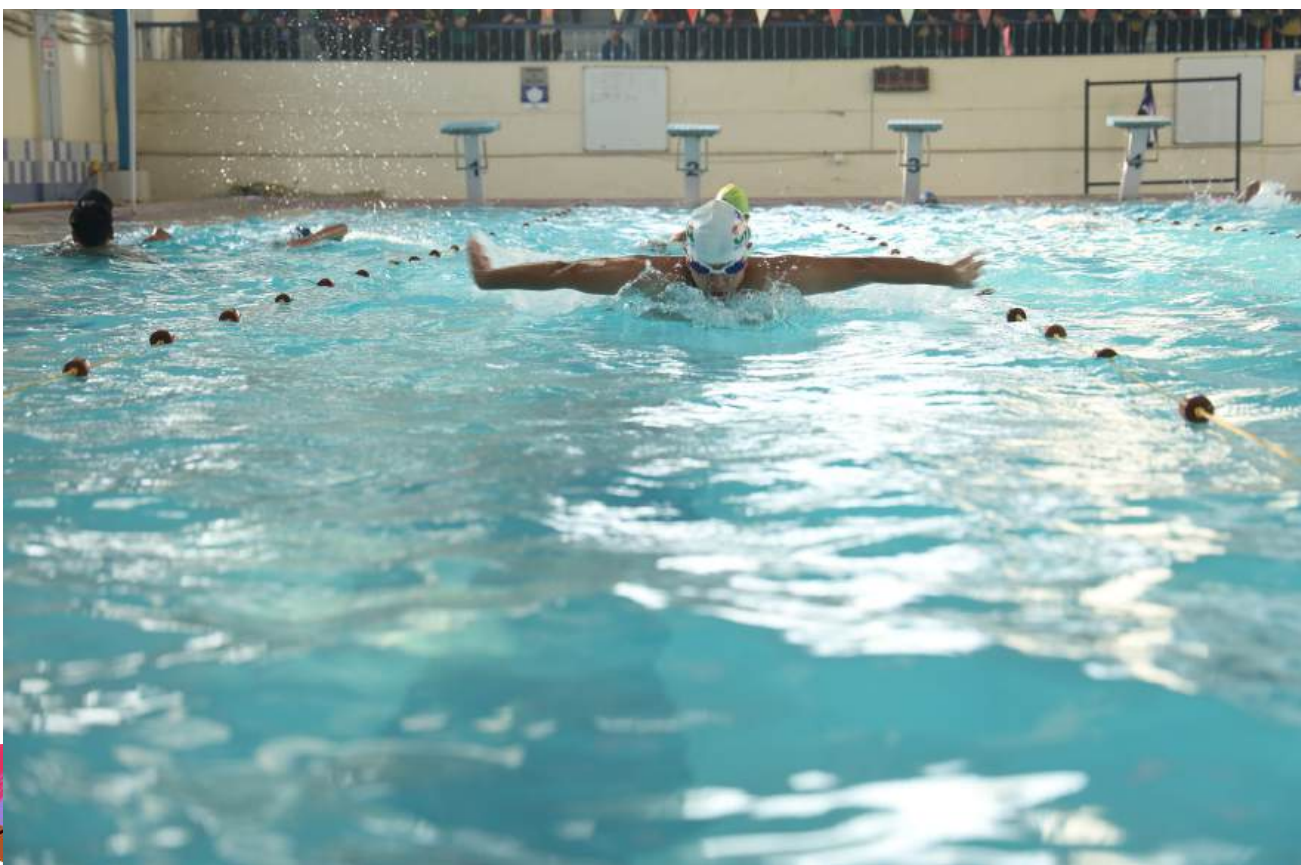

The event concluded with prize distribution and smiles all around.

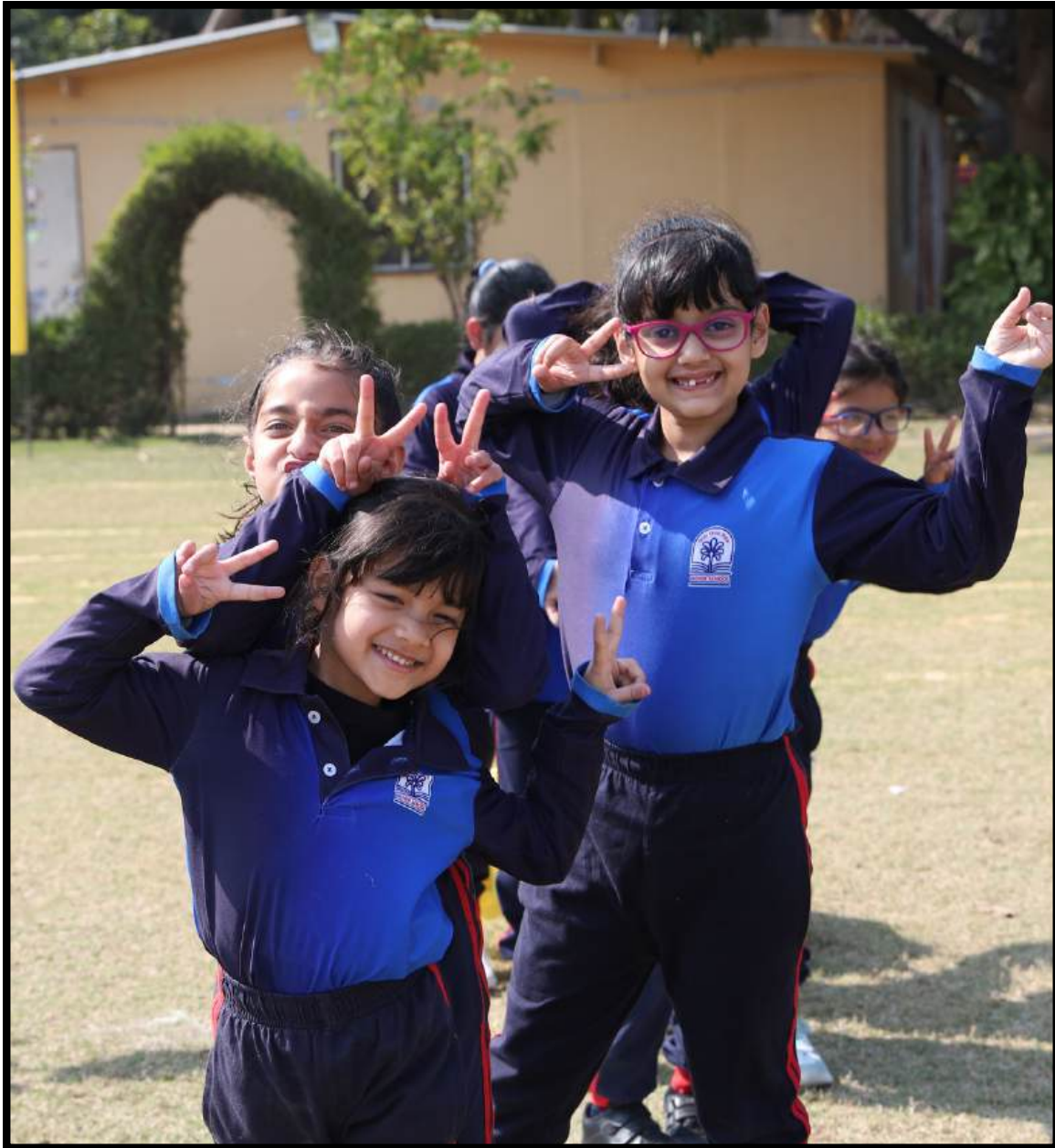
